The accounts are held in UK pounds sterling. There is a small cash holding of £80 and 440 US\$.

2023 was a challenging year for the Association, with the first face to face Congress since Covid and after a period in which membership was extended free to all members during the pandemic. Membership income is reduced post-pandemic. The increased costs of travel to Taiwan were offset for travel grant winners by increasing the amount of grant for one year only. Difficulties accessing accounts before and during the handover of the Treasurer post from Dr Ebhardt to Dr Odell caused some 2022 costs to be included in the 2023 account. A surplus for the Taiwan 2023 meeting of £2281.49 will be credited in the 2024 account.

Holding two conferences in two consecutive years is not expected to affect the financial status of the Association as they are in two widely separated locations.
